WATER SYSTEM Our water treatment facility is managed by **King Water.** To report an <u>after-hours water emergency</u>, call <u>888-266</u> <u>-7048</u>. They are working to manage the complaints we receive. Our application to install a water softener was denied by the WA State DOE. The board of trustees is working on a plan to upgrade the filtration system.

The **COMMUNITY DOCK, BEACH AND PIER** are private membership amenities for you to enjoy. The gate is installed. If you do not have a keycard and would like one, contact the office. Limit 1 per household. The float will returned by Memorial Day weekend and will remain in place through Labor Day. This facility is for **day use only**. There is no overnight moorage!

The **BASKETBALL COURT** and **BASEBALL FIELD** are available to use on a first come, first served basis. Please maintain social distancing while using these facilities or state regulations will require that we close them! For evenings, there is a push button light on the light post. The basketball court closes at 10pm. Please respect the neighbors and do not play after 10:00pm.

Beginning July 1, 2021 the **CLUBHOUSE** rental fee will increase to \$40.00 per day.

We are anticipating the pool will be open for Memorial Day weekend, May 29-31. It will then reopen, June 18 thru Labor Day. Our Pool facility is for members only with a current Pool Card. The Pool Use application & waiver are included in this newsletter and are available on the website rollinghillsglencairn.com. Fill out and return the signed forms to the office. Once the signed forms are received in the office, your card will be included with the next billing statement or may be picked up at the office.

<u>Covid-19 restricts the number of people allowed at the pool.</u> The pool will be open on a restricted basis that will comply with social distancing while allowing all members to safely enjoy the facility in **household groups only**.

Members will be able to reserve **two-1** hour time slots-up to 1 week in advance. If "<u>day of</u>" slots are available, the first text, first gets it basis, no matter if they've already used their reserved slots. We will do our best to make sure all families have the opportunity to use the facility multiple times weekly. Limits may be changed depending on usage.

Each family will be required to exit the facility prior to the next groups reservation time. No friends, guests or large groups will be allowed. Immediate family members or those <u>living</u> at a single residence will be allowed. If necessary, proof of address may be required at the pool with your pool card.

A schedule of availability will posted on our website for viewing but you will be required to <u>call or text 360-770-8344</u> to make your reservation. There is no additional charge for this private use of the pool. **See rollinghillsglencairn.com for updates, pool forms & schedules.**

Schedule: Adult swim will be 10-11 am and 6-7 pm daily.

Adults (up to 6 per session) will not be required to make advance reservations.

All other time slots will be Open Swim: Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied by an adult.

- Everyone must have a cleansing shower before entering the pool.
- If you have been ill, had a fever or diarrhea in the last 2 weeks, you may not use this facility.
- Persons under the influence of drugs or alcohol (including marijuana) are prohibited from using the pool.
- Spitting, blowing the nose or urinating in the pool is strictly forbidden.
- Non-swimmers must stay in the shallow end of the pool.
- Flips from the side of the pool, running and unauthorized games of horseplay are forbidden on the pool deck or in the water. Pushing or throwing others from the pool edge is strictly prohibited.
- NO DIVING!
- The pool attendant has the right and obligation to dismiss any person from the pool area for any infraction of the rules or disregard for their own safety or the safety of others.
- Children 12 and under must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
- Food and beverages are allowed on tan area only, not in or near the pool. This privilege will be revoked if abused.
- Properly fitted swim diapers are required to be worn by all children who are not yet potty trained.
- This is a family friendly pool. No foul language or public displays of affection (PDA's) will be not tolerated.
- Glass or other breakable containers are prohibited in the pool area.
- Smoking is not allowed. Pets are not allowed.
